OFA Level 3 is a comprehensive course designed to develop First Aid Attendants working more than 20 min from a medical facility and doing a job considered high risk. It is 70 hrs of teaching time, and includes pre-course reading, homework assignments, a multiple choice test, and a practical examination.

Students must meet the expected standards, participate fully in all activities and scenarios, and remain vigilant in their studies and practices in order to be successful on OFA Level 3.
