Throughout the pandemic Energy Safety Canada (ESC) and our training network have placed health and safety at the forefront of our planning. We have done this while also taking care of our customers and serving industry by ensuring workers continue to have access to essential training and safety resources.

As we find ourselves in a fourth wave of the COVID-19 pandemic, it's more important than ever to take steps that further support a safe working and learning environment. We believe vaccinations are the most effective tool to keep our workplace safe and healthy against this pandemic.

That is why Energy Safety Canada will be taking additional measures by requiring anyone entering our locations to be vaccinated. Here's what you need to know:

Starting December 1, 2021

- **All Employees, Instructors and Evaluators** contracted to instruct for ESC at an ESC facility will be required to confirm they are fully vaccinated.
- **Employees** requesting accommodation for reasons related to human rights code protected grounds (disability or religious beliefs) must provide supporting information that validates the reason and obtain approval by HR.
- **Instructors and Evaluators** requesting accommodation for reasons related to human rights code protected grounds (disability or religious beliefs) must provide supporting information that validates the reason and obtain approval by Tracy Simons Blow, Manager, Training.
- ESC will accommodate those who receive an approved exemption up to the point of undue hardship on ESC.

Starting December 20, 2021

- **Students, Contractors and Visitors** will be required to show government issued photo ID and proof of vaccination to access ESC facilities.
- ESC will also accept a negative COVID-19 test result within 72 hours, provided by the student, to access an ESC facility.

“Fully vaccinated” means an individual has received a full series of a Health Canada approved COVID-19 vaccine. Regardless of your vaccination status, all safeguards, including daily health screening, physical distancing and face masks, will remain in place for anyone at our facilities.

Vaccinations are the safest, most effective, and most powerful tool we have to move forward. We appreciate your cooperation during this time. Our collective efforts will help to protect the health and safety of the communities in which we live and work.
